### **Academic Progress**

As we move through the school year, we want to take a moment to emphasize the importance of staying engaged with your student's academic progress. Regularly checking in on grades and assignments can make a significant difference in their learning experience. Here are a few ways you can support your student:

- Use the Parent Portal: Our <u>online system</u> allows you to view your student's grades and assignments.
- Talk about school: Ask your student about their classes, what they're learning, and any challenges they may be facing.
- Set goals together: Encourage your student to set attainable goals and discuss strategies to achieve them.
- Reach out for support: If you have any concerns about your student's progress, please don't hesitate to reach out to us for support.

### **SCHS Grades**

You will continue to see letter grades reflected in PowerSchool to demonstrate a student's level of mastery. However, we have made a few adjustments that will provide some clarity as to what you see in PowerSchool.

- Designations of "NG" (no grade), and "I" (incomplete) have been added.
- A designation of "NG" communicates that an assignment has not been turned in or no attempt has been made to complete the assignment.
- A designation of "I" communicates that an assignment is less than
   ½ complete.

### Launch of Wisconsin's New Driver Education Grant Program

Hello champions of young, safe, and well-trained drivers!

Teens who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch can apply <u>here</u> to have their classroom and behind-the-wheel driver training paid for by the state. Students receiving grants may enroll in any driver education program offered by an authorized provider, such as a public school, CESA program, Tribal or private school, or <u>DMV-licensed driver training school</u>.

### **SmartPass Updates**

We have implemented SmartPass, a more efficient and effective process for hall passes. SmartPass is a digital version of the planners that we have used in the past. It provides school staff an accurate account of a student's location when they are outside of the classroom during the school day.

We are pleased with how the electronic pass system is working for students and staff. As we continue to have this as part of our regular routines, we are reminding students to check SmartPass to ensure they know if they need to stop by the Main Office or Student Services to pick up something or to see a pass to leave for an appointment, for example.


