Welcome to the 2025 Rock Ledge Summer Program! We are excited to offer a choice of options for students during summer school this year! Please refer to this page for general information about the different offerings available to your child this summer.

June Summer School

The June session at Rock Ledge Primary Center is offered to students who are currently in 4k-1st grade. Students currently in 2nd grade will be attending summer school at the Rock Ledge Intermediate Center. This three week session will begin on Monday, June 9th and will conclude on Thursday, June 26th. June summer school is offered from 8:00am-12:00pm, Monday-Thursday. All 5K-5th grade classes are 60 minutes long with the exception of 4k.

Registration

NEW THIS YEAR: Summer school registration will be completed online through PowerSchool. Select classes based on the grade your child's current grade. Directions for online registration are listed in the back of this packet.

Bus Transportation

NEW THIS YEAR: Students who are within the bussing boundaries may sign up to have the bus bring them to and from summer school. Please indicate if you want bussing when you are registering.

Breakfast is available

Breakfast will still be offered to all students following the same purchasing guidelines that were implemented during the school year. If you want your child to receive breakfast, please indicate it when you are registering.

Confirmation of Classes

A schedule will be sent home with your student with their report cards on the last day of school. Fallen Timbers Environmental Center

The June session of Fallen Timbers is offered to students who are currently in kindergarten-fifth grade.

- Current 5k and 1st graders: June 9th-June 13th from 12:45 pm-2:45 pm.
- Current 2nd-4th graders: June 16th-June 20th from 12:45 pm-2:45 pm.

Students may take a bus directly from Rock Ledge to Fallen Timbers. Students who will be riding the bus should arrive at Rock Ledge by 12:00 pm. Students that take the bus directly from summer school should bring a bag lunch. Anyone attending Fallen Timbers will need to be picked up at school because there isn't bussing to bring students home after Fallen Timbers.

If transportation is not needed, students should be dropped off at Fallen Timbers for 12:45 and picked up at 2:45 pm.

Step 1: Log into the [Parent Portal for PowerSchool](#) on the website (The App for PowerSchool **does not** have this option)

Step 2: Scroll down and click on "Summer Exploration"

Step 3: Select "Course Options" to see what is available for your student

- Transportation to/from Summer School select "Summer School Busing Request"
- If students will be getting breakfast at school select "Summer School Breakfast Request"

Step 4: Click on the Class you have chosen for your child. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for any sessions you wish your child to be in.
