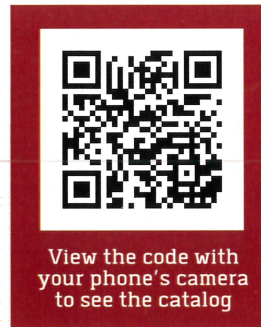

What to expect in high school in the RVA

In the RVA we encourage high schoolers to strive for their heart's desire. Grades PreK-5: Getting Off to a Great Start While Learning to Love Education

At this stage in your child's education, your time and care is most needed. You will work directly with your student utilizing book based curriculum and/or online curriculum in core subjects with a dedicated teacher there to support and guide or your student can attend live daily classes led by an RVA teacher or a mixture of both. Students have a healthy mix of workbooks, lab activities and online tools, like learning games, to engage their interests.

Grades 6-8: Becoming More Independent

In middle school, their electives open up to allow for growth at such an important time in their education. They will be either learning online, often with live teachers, from books, or a combination of those options. With your student beginning to get a more refined curriculum, the teachers also become more subject-specific. The student becomes acclimated to having multiple teachers throughout a day and the teachers pass on their passion for the individual subjects they teach.

Students with an IEP are paired with a special education teacher who assists the home educator in providing accommodations/modifications to the curriculum and selects a specific curriculum and interventions that target the student's area(s) of struggle. We also offer occupational therapy and speech and language therapy, if deemed needed as part of their IEP

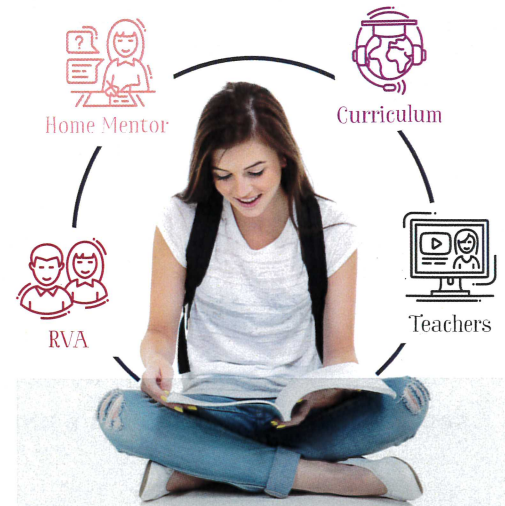
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Do you play competitive local sports in our district?
