Class Rank

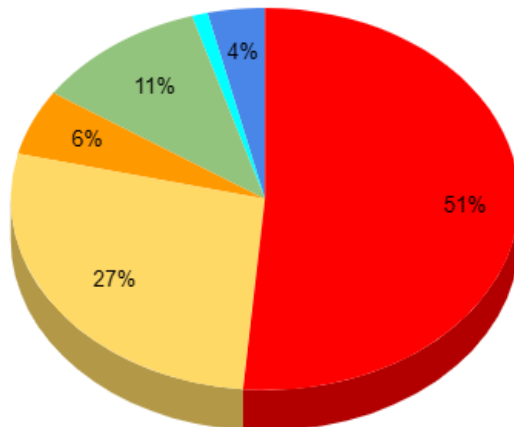
